

China's small share of an iPhone

The factory cost of an iPhone 7 is \$237.45, all of which is considered an import from China on its trade balance with the U.S. Yet a closer look reveals that just \$8.46 of that cost actually goes to China. In fact, U.S. parts make up the largest share of the total.
